

Get ready to kick start the Christmas season with an evening of live Celtic Christmas music with the talented Nigel Cameron and Julie Cameron Hall who together form 'Celtish'.

Julie is a classically trained violin player recorded her first CD in 2006 and has a total of five albums to her name (Julie Hall), the two most recent of which launched her more into the prophetic worship arena in England and throughout Europe. **Nigel Cameron**, a percussionist / Irish whistle player, photographer and worship leader from Belfast, recorded his first solo album of worship songs, *'Sunrise to Sunset'* in 2012, while on a career break from the Civil Service. In 2014 he also recorded a kids album of all-age songs called *'Get Real'*.
